

## GILBERT Family

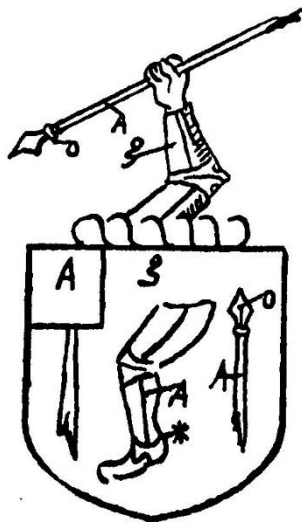
John Gilbert was the first known owner of Old Hall Farm in Fradley. He died in 1591, aged 53. He is buried at All Saints Church, Alrewas (Plot 20366) and had 2x children Thomas & John. John was a farmer and owned a lot of animals, as can be seen on the things listed on his death – [see inventory list](#)

His son, Thomas took over Old Hall Farm until his death in 1624. He is also buried at All Saints Church, Alrewas (Plot 21064). He married Elizabeth Wilson and they had 8x children.

Their son, Walter Gilbert took over Old Hall Farm c. 1650 with Humphrey, one of their other sons taking it over c. 1660. Humphrey married Elizabeth Tompson and they had 5x children.

Their daughter, Sarah Gilbert married William Goring in Alrewas on 23<sup>rd</sup> Dec 1672 and the Goring name took over Old Hall Farm. They went on to have 9x children.

Crest - A dexter arm embowed in armour gules, holding a broken spear in bend sinister, point downwards argent, headed or.

Arms – Gules, a leg in armour embowed, couped at the thigh, in pale, between two spears argent, headed or ; a canton of the second
